


Abbiamo iniziato la giornata con il Welcome to Country tradotto da Donato e poi il cantare insieme



Non Members and Children, some being students who are doing our language classes and wish to come along and practise their Italian numbers.


We have been spoilt over the last couple of months with home made beautiful Tiramisu from Donato and Sofia has been mastering the art of home made Focaccia.
